
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2018 Dodge Challenger SRT Demon: a Hellcat on Steroids?



CA is planning a mic drop ahead of the New York Auto Show when it comes to American muscle cars. That is when the automaker will stage the world debut of the 2018 Dodge Challenger SRT Demon, a Hellcat on steroids, and what is expected to be the fastest muscle car in the world.

That is saying something, given that the supercharged 6.2-liter Hemi Hellcat engine already puts out 707 hp and 650 lb-ft of torque, inducing ridiculous powerfueled grins for those who drive it in a Challenger SRT Hellcat coupe or the Charger SRT Hellcat sedan. They are currently offered with a choice of a six-speed manual transmission or an eight-speed automatic. Dodge also surprised the industry by introducing the 2015 Challenger SRT Hellcat for less than \$60,000.

"Most cars attempt to be everything to everybody. Then there are the rare few that revel in a single objective, rendering them totally irresistible to a subculture," said Tim Kuniskis, head of Dodge, SRT, Chrysler and Fiat passenger car brands for FCA North America, in a release. "The Dodge Challenger SRT Demon is conceived, designed and engineered for a subculture of enthusiasts who know that a tenth is a car and a half second is your reputation."

We don't have details or specs yet. Dodge has begun a series of pre-reveal videos that will run from today until the car is revealed in April ahead of the auto show. They will roll out weekly at www.ifyouknowyouknow.com.

For the engineers who worked on the Hellcat, the original target was to get 600 hp from the engine. Then the goal crept up to 675, then 700. In the end, the team engineered it for 707 hp.

The news of even more power from Dodge comes as speculation mounts about what to expect from the next Ford Shelby GT500 Mustang which also had an initial target of at least 600 hp and likely has also ratcheted up its ambitions.

The Demon name dates back to 1971 when Dodge offered it as a two-door fastback hardtop variant of the 1971-1972 Dodge Dart. In 2007, Dodge showed a roadster concept car which it called Demon. It never went into production.

The GT500 would take on the Chevrolet Camaro ZL1 which has the Corvette 6.2-liter V-8 under the hood, generating 650

hp and 650 lb-ft, making it the mostpowerful Camaro to date. The ZL1 has the 10-speed automatic transmission that GM developed with Ford, which means Ford's version is expected to show up in the GT500.

We await further news about the Demon and whether this is the ultimate drag racer or a street legal hot rod. Whatever the final numbers, Dodge has thrown down the gauntlet. The Hellcat has already become an icon for the Dodge brand and the Demon drop seems designed to cement its supremacy in the Motor City

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BANG BANG CHICKEN

YIELD: 6 SERVINGS PREP TIME: 20 MINUTES COOK TIME: 10 MINUTES TOTAL TIME: 30 MINUTES

Amazingly crisp chicken bites drizzled with sweet chili mayo – so good,

you'll want to double or triple the recipe!

INGREDIENTS:

1/2 cup vegetable oil, or more, as needed

1 cup buttermilk

3/4 cup all-purpose flour

1/2 cup cornstarch

1 large egg

1 tablespoon hot sauce

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste

1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1-inch chunks

1 cup Panko*

FOR THE SAUCE

1/4 cup mayonnaise

2 tablespoons sweet chili sauce

1 tablespoon honey

2 teaspoons Frank's Hot Sauce

DIRECTIONS:

To make the sauce, whisk together mayonnaise, sweet chili sauce, honey and Frank's Hot Sauce in a small bowl; set aside.

Heat vegetable oil in a large skillet over medium high heat.

In a large bowl, whisk together buttermilk, flour, cornstarch, egg, hot sauce, salt and pepper, to taste.

Working one at a time, dip chicken into buttermilk mixture, then dredge in Panko, pressing to coat.

Working in batches, add chicken to the skillet and cook until evenly golden and crispy, about 2-3 minutes. Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate.

Serve immediately, drizzled with sweet chili sauce.

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800-hp Yenko 2017 Chevrolet Corvette Unveiled Ahead of Barret-Jackson Scottsdale Debut

HUNTINGON BEACH, the California Move Hellcat. there's а 800-hp Yenko 2017 Chevrolet Corvette was unveiled earlier to a small group of media at an event held at the headquarters of Classic Industries, a Southern California-based purveyor of restoration and aftermarket parts for Chevrolet and Mopar muscle cars.

Built by Tom's River, New Jersey-based Specialty Vehicle Engineering (SVE), which uses the famous Yenko name under license, this car life starts out as conventional Corvette Grand Sport. SVE then increases the LT-1 V-8s displacement from 6.2 liters to 6.8 (or 416 cubic inches, if you prefer Imperial units), replacing a number of

components in the over, process; SVE's version is new fitted with a forged steel horsepower king in town. The crankshaft, forged aluminum pistons, and CNC ported and polished cylinder heads.

> Topping things off, literally and figuratively, is a 2.9-liter twin-screw supercharger fed by the fuel system from the LT-4 V-8 found in the Corvette Z06. In all. SVE's creation is good for 800 hp and 750 lb-ft of torque - and can be had both transmissions with offered by Chevrolet in the Grand Sport, a seven-speed manual or an eight-speed automatic.

> Aside from the engine, the the Yenko rest o f modifications appear to be purely cosmetic. Yenko badges are added throughout the exterior, interior, and are even found on the brake calipers, just to make

sure everyone knows it's a Yenko.

SVE will unveil the Yenko Corvette to the public at the Barret-Jackson 2017 Scottsdale sale. The package costs \$46,000 on top of the cost of the Grand Sport itself. It can be had with the coupe or convertible, but just 50 will be built, so get your orders in to SVE now. Unless you live in California. in which case you're out of luck as this

Yenko, unsurprisingly, does not meet the state's strict emissions regulations, most likely because SVE was unwilling to pay for CARB certification for such a small run of aftermarket engines.
