
There was no meeting in July therefore there are no minutes. Plans are in the works for cruises and other activities. Give us a call for more information.

The Eagles Aerie #2 may have to shut down again due to revised Phase 2 guidelines.


Frustrating as this is, the Gents have been invited to Jack and Rosie Haley's for an informal gather on August 5th at 6pm.

We have an October date for the show with the fairgrounds. This was the soonest date I could get with the fairgrounds to still have a show this year, and hopefully be safe to GO by then.


The 2020, 4th annual Spokane Speed and Custom Show is set for October 23-24-25 of 2020.


