



Beer Cheese Soup

- 1 TBS olive oil
- Half an onion
- 2 cloves of garlic, minced
- 3-4 stalks of celery
- 1 jalapeno
- 1 red bell pepper
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- 1 bottle of beer (basic wheat is suggested)
- 2 cups chicken or vegetable broth
- 4 TBS butter
- 4 TBS flour
- 1 cup whole milk
- 8 ounces cheddar cheese, shredded
- 4 ounces smoked cheddar, shredded
- Salt & pepper to taste

- 1. Heat the olive oil in a large soup pot (dutch oven type is recommended) over medium-high heat. Add the vegetables (onion, garlic, celery, jalapeno, red pepper, smoked paprika). Saute for a few minutes until soft.
- 2. Add half of the beer and all of the broth. Bring to a low simmer
- 3. In a separate sauce pan, melt the butter. Whisk in the flour. Cook for 5-ish minutes, stirring regularly.
- 4. Add this butter/flour mixture to the simmering soup pot. Let the soup simmer for a few minutes. It should start to thicken. Slowly whisk in the milk and remaining beer. Simmer again for 5-10 minutes until creamy and slightly thickened.
- 5. Remove from heat and wait for a few minutes for the soup to cool down slightly (to prevent clumping of cheese). Stir in the cheese until evenly melted. Season with salt and pepper and enjoy!
