Oh, there was truth and goodness In that land where we were born, Where navels were for oranges, And Peyton Place was porn.


For Ike was in the White House, And Hoss was on TV, And God was in his heaven In the Land of Sandra Dee.

Lemon Ricotta Pasta

- 1 lb. bucatini or spaghetti
- 1 cup ricotta
- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/2 cup freshly grated pecorino or parmesan
- Zest and juice from one lemon
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground pepper
- Pinch of crushed red pepper flakes
- Freshly sliced basil for serving


1. In a large pot of boiling salted water, cook pasta according to package directions. Reserve 1 cup pasta water, then drain. Return pasta to pot.

- 2. In a medium bowl, combine ricotta, oil, pecorino, lemon juice, and zest. Season with salt, pepper, and a pinch of red pepper flakes. Add ricotta mixture and 1/4 cup reserved pasta water to pasta and toss. Add more reserved pasta water if sauce is too thick.
- 3. Serve with basil, more pecorino, and a drizzle of olive oil.
