Summer Pasta Salad

Ingredients

8 ounces dry rotini pasta
½ cup red onion slivered
1 yellow pepper diced
1 small zucchini diced
1 cup grape tomatoes halved
¾ cup carrots julienned
1 corn cob grilled
½ cup radish sliced
½ cup feta cheese
2 tablespoons fresh herbs

Dressing

 ½ cup Great Value Organic Extra Virgin Olive Oil
 3 tablespoons Great Value Organic Raw Unfiltered Apple Cider Vinegar
 ½ teaspoon Great Value Organic Oregano
 ½ teaspoon Great Value Organic Garlic Powder
 1 tablespoon dijon
 1 teaspoon sugar salt and pepper

Instructions

Cook pasta al dente according to package directions. Drain and run under cold water to stop cooking.

Combine all dressing ingredients In a mason jar and shake well to combine.

Combine pasta and remaining ingredients in a large bowl. Toss top combine. Top with additional feta cheese and herbs if desired.

Notes

We used fresh dill and parsley but any fresh herbs are great in this summer pasta salad.


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
